## Church Army Serving the Church

Church Army had a table at the 2019 ACNA Assembly in Plano Texas. Many people had never heard of Church Army and asked us the question, "Are you like the Salvation Army?" The answer is both "Yes" and "No". The founders of

both organizations wanted to reach the poor in London with the gospel in the late 19th century. They even worked together to do so. The key difference is that the founder of Church Army, Wilson Carlile, believed that the church and the sacraments were a necessity in reaching the poor - and that the poor should be welcomed into the church. It was in line with Carlile's vision that Church Army was present at the Assembly. We exist to serve the church as we help the church to serve the lost..

### **What can we give to the church?**

The simple answer is "a zeal for evangelism".
